Principal's Message

School is well and truly back!

This week we have had 93% of students present and back enjoying their Ponsonby Experience.

The systems and procedures we put in place worked well and the students have been fantastic in following the rules. They understand about their 'personal space', they have been diligent in their handwashing and students presenting with sickness have not come to school.

Having the school running an effective bubble system during Alert Level 3 also helped us in our preparation.

We started school back with an overly cautious approach and avoided cross grouping situations. This week has shown us our systems can be trusted, so by keeping a careful register we may start to open up cross grouping next week. This means potential Basketball trials, Rock band try outs, Showquest and other sports teams may start.

This is important and exciting as you have heard me say it before – student engagement is a key factor in student learning.

Our Deputy Principal, Matt Bennie, has kept a daily register of students using bus services. A requirement asked of us by Auckland Transport. As I highlighted in the last newsletter, bus services were a bit of an unknown factor moving into Level 2. Unfortunately, our concerns were correct. I can assure you, we are in "discussions" with the Metro team at Auckland Transport. At this stage my best advice is for students and parents to organise a *'plan B'* in case buses fail to accommodate students. The problems have been around the afternoon return trips towards Mt Albert.
